

## **UMAP Programs**

UMAP member universities / institutions can participate in the following programs:

#### **UMAP Multilateral Student Exchange Program [UME]**

UME is a multilateral exchange program in which UMAP universities can send and receive two students per year. Exchanges are made between UMAP universities on a tuition-waiver basis.

Programs can last one or two semesters, beginning in fall or spring semester.

#### **UMAP Bilateral Student Exchange Program [UBE]**

Bilateral student exchange arrangements can be made between any two UMAP universities on a tuition-waiver basis.

#### **UMAP Student Exchange on Special Courses [USC]**

USC are short-term (2-4 weeks) programs offered by UMAP universities.

Scholarships are awarded to students selected from among the participants in these programs.

#### **UMAP Credit Transfer Scheme [UCTS]**

The UMAP Credit Transfer Scheme (UCTS) ensures that the credits students earn while participating in exchange programs are smoothly transferred to students' home universities. This will facilitate greater mobility between UMAP countries / territories and other regions.

#### **Research Net [RN]**

Research Net is a funding scheme designed to encourage joint research projects, collaboration, and exchange among groups of researchers from different UMAP countries / territories.
